### 1. Health Insurance

We assume you will be covered by your provincial health insurance company. If that is not the case please ask us about *SemCare Health Insurance*. Calvin Seminary requires that all students, their spouses, and children are covered by health insurance.

### 2. Tuition - Summer Course for EPMC Students

Summer Seminar Course (IDIS 910) for EPMC Students \$500

If you wish to pursue permission from Vice President Duane Kelderman to take the two, 2-hour courses that comprise the EPMC Seminar for academic credit, the current tuition rate = \$263 per credit hour (6 hours x \$263= \$1,578)

### 3. Tuition - Fall Quarter

Tuition for the Fall Quarter for EPMC students is 11 hours x \$263 per hour = \$2,893.

### 4. Books

The cost of books is approximately \$100 for the two-week summer session and \$400 for the Fall Quarter.

**5. Rent – Two weeks**

\*If you are staying with friends for the two weeks and won't be paying rent just subtract the amount for rent from the total.

If coming alone we assume \$220 a month (4 weeks) if living with two other students in seminary housing divided by 2 for two weeks = \$110.

If coming with spouse – rent for a small one bedroom Boerema Townhouse in seminary housing is \$575 per month divided by 2 for two weeks = \$288.

If coming with spouse and one child – rent for a small two bedroom in seminary housing is \$590 per month divided by 2 = \$295.

If coming with spouse and two children – rent for a larger two bedroom in seminary housing is \$640 per month divided by 2 = \$320.

**6. Rent – Fall Quarter**

If coming alone rent is \$230 per month if living with two other students in seminary housing x 3 months = \$690.

If coming with spouse – rent for a small one bedroom Boerema Townhouse in seminary housing is \$575 per month x 3 = \$1725.

If coming with spouse and one child – rent for a small two bedroom in seminary housing is \$590 per month x 3 = \$1,770.

If coming with spouse and two children – rent for a larger two bedroom in seminary housing is \$640 per month x 3 = \$1,920.

**7. Food – Two Weeks (You are welcome to use the Idema Food Pantry and Clothes Closet located in the basement.)**

If coming alone – food for one year is estimated at \$1205 divided by 52 x 2 = \$46 for two weeks.

If coming with spouse – food for one year is estimated at \$2163 divided by 52 x 2 = \$83 for two weeks.

If coming with spouse and one child food for one year is estimated at \$2740 divided by 52 x 2 = \$106 for two weeks.

If coming with spouse and two children add \$20.

**8. Food – For Fall Quarter (You are welcome to use the Idema Food Pantry and Clothes Closed located in the basement.)**

If coming alone – food for one year is estimated at \$1205 divided by 12 x 3 = \$301.

If coming with spouse – food for one year is estimated at \$2163 divided by 12 x 3 = \$540.

If coming with spouse and one child food for one year is estimated at \$2740 divided by 12 x 3 = \$685.

If coming with spouse and two children add \$135.

**9. Personal Expenses – Two Weeks**

If coming alone – personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$2440 divided by 52 x 2 = \$94.

If coming with spouse personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$3693 divided by 52 x 2 = \$142.

If coming with spouse and one child personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$4017 divided by 52 x 2 = \$155.

If coming with spouse and two children add \$15.

**10. Personal Expenses – Fall Quarter**

If coming alone personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$2440 divided by 12 x 3 = \$610.

If coming with spouse personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$3693 divided by 12 x 3 = \$923.

If coming with spouse and one child personal expenses for one year are estimated at \$4017 divided by 12 x 3 = \$1004.

If coming with spouse and two children add \$90

**11. Transportation – Two weeks**

Transportation for one year is estimated at \$2940 divided by 52 x 2 = \$113.

**12. Transportation – Fall Quarter**

Transportation for on year is estimated at \$2940 divided by 12 x 3 = \$735.
